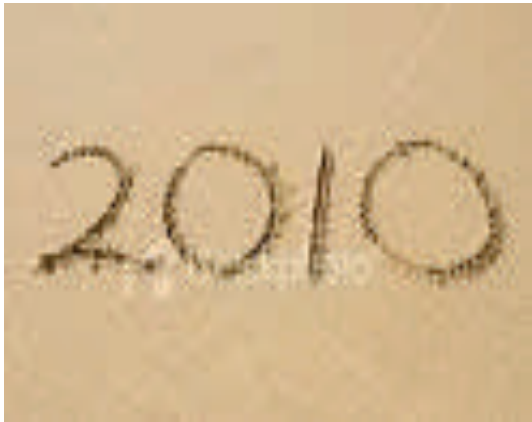

torcycles a lot and continue to work hard on community events and traditional activities of the Noble Eagles.

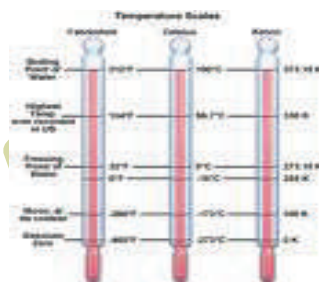


Ride the Degree!
